2024 Edgartown Regatta Tips

Where do I keep my boat?

There are essentially two choices:

- Anchoring in the outer harbor (North of Chappy, East of Chappy Beach Club)
 - Bring your own ground tackle! This area is free with decent holding ground. Reasonably well protected except in a NE wind. During those times, the harbormaster usually opens Katama Bay (past the inner harbor) for mooring until the NE wind ceases.
 - Both Oldport Launch (fee) and EYC launch (free) provide access. (Oldport will provide "free" service if you have an EYC Regatta wristband.) Note that launch drivers generally expect a tip for service.

• Town rental mooring

- \$45/night with an additional \$20/night if you want to raft a second boat. Mooring registration opens on March 4th at 08:00 EST. Moorings are rented through Dockwa (https://dockwa.com or download their App). We suggest you set up an account in advance, so you don't have to deal with that when moorings open. They do go fast!
- Both Oldport Launch (fee) and EYC launch (free) provide access. (Oldport will provide "free" service if you have an EYC Regatta wristband.)

When sailing in the inner Harbor, please remember the Chappy Ferry ALWAYS has the right of way. They do their best to not interfere too much with boats under sail, but they ALWAYS have the right of way.
